Dear ENQA Board,

On behalf of the Aragon Agency for Quality Assurance and University Foresight in Higher Education (ACPUA), I am pleased to express our sincere interest in undergoing the third external review against the Standards and Guidelines for Quality Assurance in the European Higher Education Area (ESG).

We are the official independent higher education evaluation agency of the Autonomous Community of Aragon whose main purpose is to guarantee and promote the quality of its university system. We have the obligation to ensure that our evaluation, certification and accreditation activities respond faithfully to the ESG.

In 2016 the ACPUA accredited compliance with the ESG, acquiring the status of full member of ENQA, which was renewed in 2021. The Agency's purpose in remaining a full member of ENQA and therefore registered in the European Quality Assurance Register (EQAR), is to enable the continuation of quality assessment in higher education, to serve as an endorsement and to strengthen its presence at national and international level through compliance with the European guidelines.

We are therefore ready for the third review, in the targeted review modality, to be completed by June 2026. Thus, the Self-Assessment Report (SAR) of the ACPUA is expected to be finalised by June 2025, in the expectation that it will be concluded by June 2026.
